Day-by-Day Itinerary

- D1

Arrival in Marrakech

Arrive at Marrakech Menara Airport. Riad hotel check-in in the medina. Welcome mint tea ceremony. Evening at Djemaa el-Fna square — snake charmers, storytellers, food stalls.
- D2

Marrakech Medina & Souks

Bahia Palace, Medersa Ben Youssef (14th-century Islamic college), Saadian Tombs. Guided souk walk — spices, leather tanneries from above, lantern makers.
- D3

Atlas Mountains & Berber Villages

Day trip to the High Atlas Mountains. Walk through Berber villages. Traditional Berber home lunch. Ouzoud Waterfalls with wild Barbary macaques.
- D4

Marrakech to Fes via Meknes

Drive north via Meknes — UNESCO-listed imperial city and Bab Mansour gate. Roman ruins of Volubilis. Arrive Fes at sunset.
- D5

Fes el Bali — Ancient Medina

Full day in Fes el Bali (largest car-free urban area on earth). Bou Inania Medersa, Al-Attarine, Chouara Tanneries (best at 10 AM), Al-Qarawiyyin University.
- D6

Fes to Sahara Desert Drive

Scenic drive through the Middle Atlas. Cedar forest with Barbary macaques. Arrive Merzouga dunes at sunset — camel ride into the Sahara.
- D7

Sahara Sunrise & Return to Marrakech

Predawn camel ride to watch Sahara sunrise. Traditional desert breakfast in Berber camp. Drive back via Todra Gorge. Return to Marrakech for departure.

What's Included & Excluded

INCLUDED

- ✓ Riad accommodation in Marrakech (2 nights) and Fes (2 nights)
- ✓ Desert camp (1 night, dinner + breakfast)
- ✓ Hotel in transit (1 night)
- ✓ Daily breakfast
- ✓ Private air-conditioned vehicle throughout
- ✓ Local guide in Marrakech, Fes, and Sahara
- ✓ Camel ride at Erg Chebbi
- ✓ Volubilis entry ticket
- ✓ Airport transfer in Marrakech

EXCLUDED

- ✗ International flights
- ✗ Morocco visa (most nationalities visa-free)
- ✗ Lunches and most dinners
- ✗ Personal expenses
- ✗ Travel insurance
- ✗ Camera fees at tanneries

What to Bring

- ✓ Warm layers for desert nights (can drop to 5°C in winter)
- ✓ Light long sleeves for sun protection and medina modesty
- ✓ Comfortable walking shoes (medina cobblestones are uneven)
- ✓ Headscarf for women (useful in mosques)
- ✓ Sandals for riad and hammam visits
- ✓ Cash Moroccan Dirham for souks and tips
- ✓ Sunglasses and sun hat

Cancellation Policy
